**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF GOLF CARTS, RTVs, UTVs, ATVs and
OTHER GAS, ELECTRIC, or DIESEL DRIVEN VEHICLES**

IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW HOLLAND, ILLINOIS

Published in paper form by the authority of the Board of Trustees of the Village of New Holland,
Logan County, Illinois, this 11 day of January 2023.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Holland, Logan County, Illinois, believes that regulation of the use of golf carts, RTVs, UTVs, ATVs and other gas, diesel, or electric driven vehicles ("Vehicles") is necessary to promote safety in the Village;

WHEREAS, the Vehicles regulated under this ordinance are as follows: golf carts, RTVs, UTVs, ATVs and any similar thing used to transport people or goods powered by gas, electric, or diesel means;

WHEREAS, there will be no permit fees associated with this ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of Vehicle(s) shall be permitted on streets under the jurisdiction of the Village of New Holland and/or within its corporate boundaries only as set forth in this Article. Vehicle(s) may only be operated on Village streets between sunrise and sunset. Vehicle(s) shall operate in accordance with the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5);

WHEREAS, a slow moving vehicle sign, a triangle reflective safety sign, or a flashing light must be present on each Vehicle which is displayed in a manner that is clearly visible from a distance of 500 feet;

WHEREAS, any person operating a golf cart, RTV, UTV, ATV or like vehicle must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license;

WHEREAS, all motor, gas, electric, or diesel vehicles must have operational brakes in good working order, and

WHEREAS, all motor, gas, electric or diesel golf carts, RTVs, UTVs, ATVs or like vehicles must not be operated on the Village roads after dark unless the vehicle has headlights and taillight,;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of New Holland, Logan County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the recitals above are incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth below.

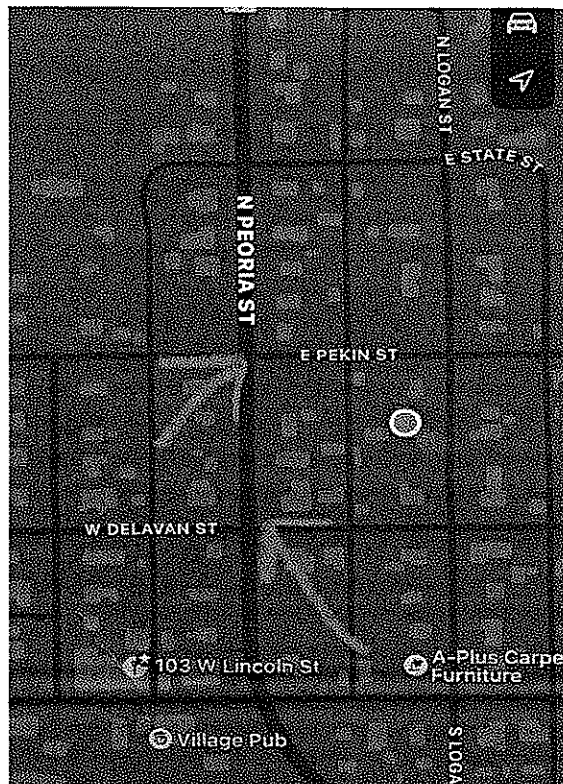
**Section 2:
OPERATIONS:**

The operation of Vehicle(s), as defined under this Ordinance, shall be permitted on streets under the jurisdiction of the Village of New Holland and/or within its corporate boundaries only as set forth in this Article. Vehicle(s) may only be operated on Village streets between sunrise and sunset. Vehicle(s) shall operate in accordance with the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5) and the manufactures' suggested operational procedures and limitations..

Vehicles SHALL NOT be operated under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or any other substance prohibited under the Illinois Vehicle Code and/or the manufactures' suggested operating procedures.

Vehicles shall not exceed speeds over 25 mph.

Vehicle(s) shall not operate directly on Illinois Route 10. Vehicle(s) are permitted to make a direct crossing of Illinois Route 10 at the intersection at Delavan Street and Pekin Street as shown on the map below:



**Section 3:
PERMITS & WAIVERS**

No person shall operate a "Vehicle(s)" within the Village of New Holland without first obtaining a permit or being listed as an additional operator under a permit, as provided herein. The permit (registration) stickers placed on the "Vehicle(s)" must be visible at all times during its operation.

There is no cost for the permit.

Section 3.1:

Applications for a permit shall be made on a form supplied by the Village, shall be executed by the applicant and each additional operator and shall contain the following:

- Name and address of applicant.
- Name and address of any additional operators.
- A copy of valid driver's license for the applicant and each operator.
- Name of liability insurance carrier and policy number.
- The S/N or VIN, Make, Model and Description of "Vehicle(s)."
- Waiver of liability.
- Any such other and additional information as the Village may require.

Additional operators should be added to a Vehicle's permit prior to that Vehicle's operation by the additional operator.

It is the applicant's responsibility for ensuring that the necessary and applicable information for each operator for a Vehicle is current and up-to-date with the Village of New Holland. Failing to maintain current and up-to-date information or providing false information in the permitting process may lead to immediate and permanent revocation of a permit under this Ordinance.

Section 3.2

Annual renewal of a permit:

- The applicant must provide evidence of insurance each year in compliance with the provisions of the Illinois Statutes regarding minimum liability insurance for passenger motor vehicles to be operated on the roads of the State of Illinois.
- The applicant must provide a new copy of the driver's license of the applicant and each operator if said license expired during the previous year.

Section 3.3
Special Events

It is the responsibility for any individual operating a Vehicle(s) under this Ordinance to be aware of and remain compliant with any changes the Village may make, in its sole discretion, without notice, to any section of this Ordinance, including, but not limited to, Operations for special events or road construction, which may impact normal activity under this Ordinance.

Section 4:
FINES

Any person who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$75.00 and not to exceed \$150.00

Section 5:
REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

The operation of Vehicle(s) within the Village shall be in accordance with all provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5). "Vehicle(s)" must have, at a minimum, the following equipment:

- Brakes;
- Brake Lights;
- Slow moving emblem or orange flag in the rear of Vehicle(s);
- Headlights – emits white light visible from 300 feet when in operation; and
- Tail Lights – emits red light visible from 300 feet when in operation.

For any Vehicle equipment with safety restraints, *e.g.* seat belts, shoulder harnesses, those restraints must be used during operation of the Vehicle. Any one operating a Vehicle under this Ordinance shall also follow the manufactures' suggested operating procedures as it pertains to safety equipment.

Section 6: Ordinance in Force

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording, and publication as provided by law.

The Village President of New Holland and the Board of Trustees of New Holland, Illinois, pass and approve this ordinance shall be in full force and effect commencing

January 11, 2023.
